The adult applicant was granted subsidiary protection status in Malta on 01/03/2014 and her children were granted the same protection as the mother. However, according to our records, they have failed to come to our premises to renew their protection certificates, which expired on 26/03/2018. In view of this, and in accordance with the amendments to Chapter 420 of the Laws of Malta (Act XL of 2020), which came into force on 07<sup>th</sup> August 2020, it can be concluded that international protection has lapsed. Therefore, this individual is no longer a beneficiary of international protection in Malta and the persons concerned will not be allowed to enter Malta.
